Introduction

Elementary Power is an online course, consisting of 100 units of English, and providing approximately 120 hours of study for students.

<u>Course aims</u>

To take students from Elementary, CEFR A1 up to A2. The course blends grammatical structures necessary for this level, with vocabulary, including simple verb + preposition combinations, spelling, reading, listening, writing and speaking.

<u>Grammar</u>

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- use present simple and present continuous verbs forms, as well as simple past with regular and irregular verbs.
- identify things using there is/there are, have got, possessive adjectives and pronouns, and the possessive genitive
- talk about adjectives, including using comparative and superlative forms
- create yes/no and information questions
- give information on time and place using prepositions
- use the modal verbs can and could
- use adverbs of frequency

Vocabulary

By the end of the course students will have learnt approximately 800 lexical items, including common nouns, verbs and adjectives, and simple lexical sets.

<u>Skills</u>

By the end of the course students will have had exposure to and practice in reading and hearing about everyday routines, biographies, countries and cities, TV and films and simple stories
