Let's start, course B is an online course, consisting of 40 units of English, and providing approximately 40 hours of study for students.

Students should not study Let's start, course B unless that have already completed Let's start, **course A**, as the lexis and grammar revised at the end of each module includes material studied in Let's start, course A

Course aims

To take students from absolute beginner, CEFR A0/A1- up to A1, where they can start studying an elementary course. The course focuses on basic grammatical forms and essential, high frequency lexis.

Grammar

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- use the verb to be in the affirmative, negative and interrogative with nouns, verbs in the • present participle, and adjectives.
- use the present simple and present continuous forms of verbs. •
- use demonstratives, there is/there are, and can as a modal verb for ability •
- create questions beginning with question words for information, and auxiliary verbs for • affirmative or negative answers.

Vocabulary

By the end of the course students will have learnt approximately 75 common nouns, and had practice in numbers and the alphabet as well as substantial spelling practice.
